Cable installation works - Overnight working

I am writing to inform you about out of hours working that will be taking place in the next few weeks to install new cabling into existing ducts as part of an upgrade to the tram signalling system. To avoid disruption to services we will need to carry out the majority of this work when the tram is not operating. We have been given permission to work at the following times:

- **Mosley Street Tram stop to Windmill Street**
22/02/10 to 05/03/10 - 8pm to 8am
- **Mosley Street Tram stop to Church Street:**
22/02/10 to 03/03/10 - 8pm to 8am
- **Junction of Aytoun St / Portland Street to junction of Mosley Street / Piccadilly Gardens:**
25/02/10 to 12/03/10 – 8pm to 8am

We do not expect this work to be disruptive, however to minimise disruption to local residents during this work we will put the following measures in place:

- Disable the external klaxon on vehicles.
- Use flashing amber beacons, vehicle headlights and small helmet mounted torches instead of fixed position lighting rigs.
- Use hand held tools rather than tools requiring generators.
- Use hand held radios turned low to avoid workers needing to raise voices.

Please note that construction sites can be dangerous places – sites are fenced in for the protection of the public. **For your own safety, please do not try to access the site. There will be no need for anyone to enter your property or business.**
